

## MEDICAL ASSISTING PROGRAM QUALIFICATIONS

(Effective Academic Year 2008 - 2009)

The first applicants to qualify by meeting the COMPASS Reading score (74 or higher) and COMPASS Math score (placement into Math 24 or higher) will be accepted until the quota is met for the Medical Assisting program. Evidence of completion of ENG 22 and PCM 23 are accepted in lieu of placement test results. You may obtain and submit your application to Health Sciences department (see MEDA Program Director or Health Sciences counselor for academic advising and support).

Develop an academic action plan with a Health Sciences counselor if you do not meet the minimum qualifications for acceptance or need more time to prepare for the MEDA program. Students may enroll in the MEDA general education requirements and program support courses.
