### **NO PURGE (DIS-ENROLLMENT) FOR NON-PAYMENT OF TUITION**

You will not be purged (dis-enrolled) from your Summer 2017 class(es) when you register for a class. If you have not paid your tuition/fees, did not officially drop a class that you have stopped attending, or never attended:

- You will be held responsible for payment of tuition and fees unless you drop your classes **within the stated refund deadlines** for each class;
- A financial obligation will be placed on your records (after 30 days of the start of instruction), even if you do not attend the class; and
- You will receive a failing grade for the class.

**TUITION NOTE:** UH Community Colleges Summer 2017 rates for 1) remedial/developmental classes; and, 2) college success courses or other classes taught as part of a learning community that includes remedial/developmental classes are charged AY 2016-2017 rates (i.e., residents \$126; nonresidents \$340).

**FINAL GRADES:** There is only **one** summer session regardless of when the course starts. Summer grades are only rolled once. Summer 2017 session grades will be available on or after August 15, 2017.
