SUBJECT: **GRADUATION AND PERSISTENCE RATES,
AS OF AUGUST 2014**

The attached table reports graduation and persistence rates for the University of Hawai'i campuses as of August 2014. The information is provided in compliance with the Student Right-to-Know (SRTK) Act, Public Law 101-542. Institutions are required by Sec. 668.41 of the law to disclose and disseminate this information through appropriate publications and mailings to all currently enrolled and prospective students. The publications and/or mailings must be ones to which every student has access, such as the schedule of classes and campus catalog. Merely posting the information, for example on a bulletin board or providing the flyer only upon request, is not considered sufficient disclosure.

All UH campuses are required to disclose the information. Though the table shows data for ten UH campuses, each campus at its discretion may publish only its own rates. To comply with the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008, the disaggregated graduation rates by gender, race/ethnicity, and Federal Pell Grant or subsidized Stafford Loan recipient status must be published for each campus.

The flyer is accessible on the web at <http://www.hawaii.edu/irao/srtk/> in PDF and Excel formats. The information will also be published in the "How to Enroll" instruction booklet which accompanies the UH application form.

Please ensure that the graduation rate information is published in your upcoming schedule of classes (SOC) and campus catalog, including the online versions. NOTE: Because of the varied formats utilized by the campuses and the necessity for compliance auditing, we request that you provide us with a printed or electronic version of your announcement and/or the specific source (e.g., SOC, catalog, URL, etc.). You should continue to publish the information in subsequent publications until you receive an update like this next year.
