



Associate in Science Degree in Nursing Program Outcomes

The Nursing Department at Kapi'olani Community College (KCC) is pleased to inform students, faculty and the community about the program outcomes for its Associate in Science degree in nursing program. Several major outcomes are regularly monitored in order to continually improve the nursing program at KCC: **graduate completion rate, NCLEX-RN (licensure) pass rate, graduated student satisfaction, employer satisfaction, and job placement rate.** The Associate in Science degree in nursing program is offered at the Diamond Head campus and its satellite campus site at Leeward Community College. There is also a program for licensed practical nurses to become registered nurses through the Associate in Science degree in nursing (Transition for Licensed Practical Nurses) program (also referenced as the LPN to RN Transition Program).

Graduate Completion Rate: The graduate completion rate is the percent of students completing the nursing program within four to six semesters.

Graduated Student Satisfaction: Graduated student satisfaction surveys are conducted 12 months after graduation. Graduates are asked if they believe the KCC program prepared them for work as an entry level registered nurse. Graduates from 2010 to 2012 reported that the KCC nursing program prepared them “well” to “very well” to meet the role of the entry level registered nurse.

Employer Satisfaction: Employer satisfaction surveys are conducted to determine if their employees graduating from the KCC nursing program are able to work as entry level registered nurses in their facility. All employers reported KCC nursing program graduates “meet” or “exceeds” their expectations of an entry level registered nurse in surveys conducted in 2010 to 2012.

Job Placement Rate: The job placement rate is the percent of graduates who find employment as a registered nurse within 12 months after graduation.
