

**Admission Agreement Between
The University at Albany State University of New York
and
The University of Hawai'i – Kapi'olani Community College**

To promote understanding and goodwill, to strengthen cultural ties, to promote research and development, and to broaden student experience and horizons, the University at Albany, State University of New York, (hereafter referred to as SUNY Albany) and the University of Hawaii – Kapi'olani Community College (hereafter referred to as KCC). SUNY agree to the following terms of collaboration outlined below:

International students who apply directly to KCC and intend to transfer to SUNY – Albany will be eligible for admissions provided they submit the required documents and meet all of the requirements listed below:

1. Apply online: [Common Application](#) or [SUNY Application](#)


Transfer applicants who apply through the SUNY Application must complete the required [Part II application online](#). Transfer applicants who apply through the Common Application submit their supplemental information directly through the Common Application.

2. Most programs at SUNY Albany require a minimum 2.5 overall GPA, but several programs require a higher GPA and/or specific entrance requirements for transfer students. Prospective transfers who do not meet the requirements may be offered an alternate major option.
 - Accounting, Business Administration and Digital Forensics require a minimum 3.25 overall GPA.
 - Criminal Justice requires a minimum 3.2 overall GPA and completion of additional application materials after an initial review of application and transcript(s).
 - Financial Market Regulation requires a minimum 3.2 overall GPA.
 - Bio-Instrumentation, Human Development and Public Health require a minimum 3.0 overall GPA.
 - Social Welfare requires a minimum 3.0 overall GPA and completion of additional application materials after an initial review of application and transcript(s). Admission granted only for the fall semester.
3. A TOEFL score of 70 (iBT) or 213 (CBT) or IELTS of 6.0 is required of all international students. With a C or better in English Composition at KCC the TOEFL or IELTS will be waived.

SUNY-Albany will issue the conditional letter of admission to KCC after KCC has sent the contact information of students who choose this guaranteed conditional admission. KCC will mail this letter from SUNY – Albany to the students who select the program.


