



NOTICE: Kapi'olani Community College Fall 2019 tuition and fees must be paid **in full** by 4:00 pm (HST) on Thursday, August 15, 2019, or you will be disenrolled from all of your classes.



If you registered in classes, but **do not plan to attend** in the Fall semester, login to STAR at www.star.hawaii.edu and drop your classes to ensure that you are not charged. In STAR GPS Registration, three asterisks *** indicate that you are registered for a class.

If you have any unpaid balance for the Fall semester at that time, all of your classes will be dropped. There are a few exceptions:



Financial Aid & Scholarship Recipients.

If you have been awarded federal financial aid or scholarships that will cover the *entire* balance of your tuition and fees, you will not be disenrolled. Verify your Financial Aid status at MyUH: myuh.hawaii.edu. Contact the [financial aid office](#) if you have any questions.



Payment Plan.
