Graduation Rate, Employment Rate, Pass Rate on NPTE
August 2021

1. Graduation Rate

The cumulative graduation rate for students admitted to the Physical Therapist Assistant (PTA) Program is listed below. CAPTE standards: **Graduation Rate:** The percentage of students who are matriculated in the first technical course in the program after the add/drop period and who complete the program. Graduation rates are at least 60%, averaged over two years.

- Class of 2018 – graduation rate = 100.0 % (15/15) graduation date August 2018
- Class of 2019 – graduation rate = 100% (16/16) graduation date August 2019
- Class of 2020 – graduation rate = 82.4% (14/17) graduation date August 2020
- Class of 2021 – graduation rate = 94.4% (17/18) graduation date August 2021

Two-year average (classes 2020 - 2021) = 88.6%

2. Employment Rate

The employment rate for graduates of the PTA Program is listed below. Employment rate is based CAPTE calculation standard: Employment rates are at least 90%, averaged over two years. Employment rate: The percentage of graduates who sought employment that were employed (fulltime or part-time) as a physical therapist assistant within 1 year following graduation. Also achieves jurisdiction license.

- Class of 2018 (start August 2017) = 100%
- Class of 2019 (start August 2018) = 100%
- Class of 2020 (start August 2019) = 100%

Two-year average (classes 2019-2020) = 100%

3. Pass Rate on NPTE as of August 10, 2020 report.

The licensure pass rate for graduates is listed below based on CAPTE standards and calculated by FSBPT. Ultimate licensure pass rates are at least 85%, averaged over two years. Licensure pass rate: The percentage of graduates who take and successfully pass the National Physical Therapy Examination (NPTE). Rates are considered to be stabilized one year after graduation.

2019	46.7%	93.3%	94.5%
2020	63.6%	100%	91.9%

Two-year average Ultimate pass rate (classes 2019 - 2020) = 96.15%
