



**Kapi'olani Community College
 Associate in Science Degree in Nursing
 Program Outcomes**

The Nursing Department at Kapi'olani Community College (KCC) is pleased to share with our community the program outcomes for its Associate in Science degree in nursing program. To ensure that the program is in compliance with the accrediting agency, Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN), the following program outcomes are monitored: **NCLEX-RN (licensure) pass rate and program completion rate**. Kapi'olani Community College has two pathways to obtain an Associate in Science (A.S.) degree in nursing: a non-licensed (traditional) pathway and licensed practical nurse (transition) pathway. The data will be displayed separately and aggregated.

Outcome 1: NCLEX (Licensure) Pass Rate - The program demonstrates evidence of graduates' achievement on the licensure examination. The program's most recent annual licensure examination pass rate will be at least 80% for all first-time test-takers during the same 12-month period.

Outcome 2: Program Completion Rate - The program demonstrates evidence of students' achievement in completing the nursing program. For the traditional AS in nursing program option, at least 70% will complete the program within 6 academic terms. For the AS in nursing transition for licensed practical nurses program option, at least 70% will complete the program within 5 academic terms.
