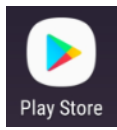
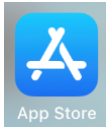
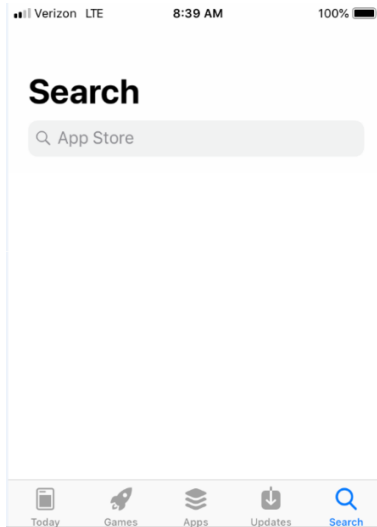


Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA), ie. DUO Registration Instructions

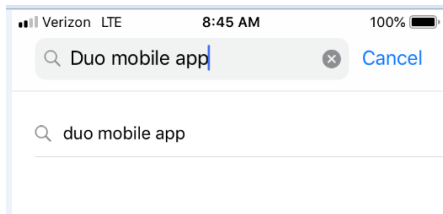
1. Log into the App Store on an iPhone or the Play Store on an Android. NOTE: Remaining photos depict iPhone screens, but steps on an Android are similar.



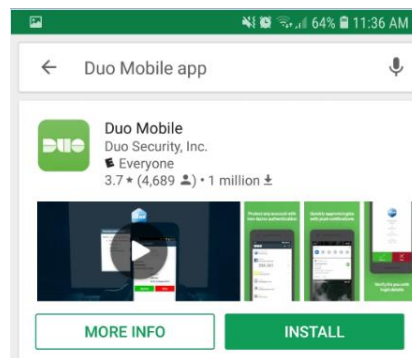
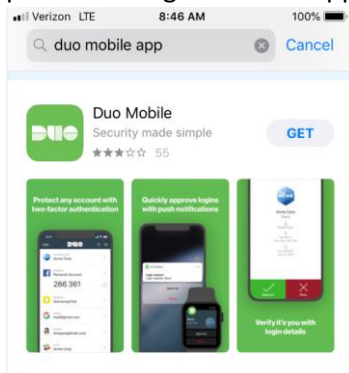
2. Click the magnifying glass icon at the bottom right hand corner of your phone screen.



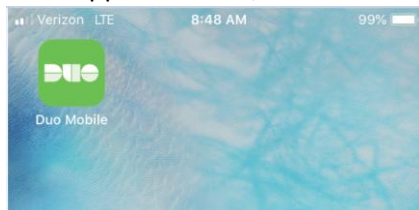
3. In the search bar, type in "DUO Mobile" app.



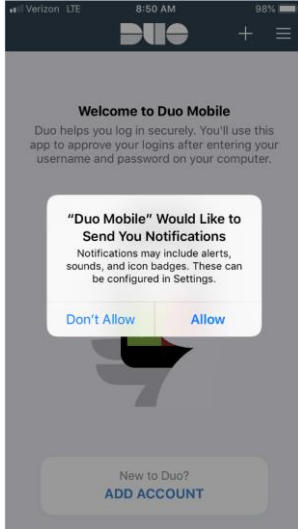
4. Search for the icon pictured below. Click the "GET" button on the iPhone or click "INSTALL" on an Android phone and login in to the app store to confirm purchase (NOTE: The app is free.)



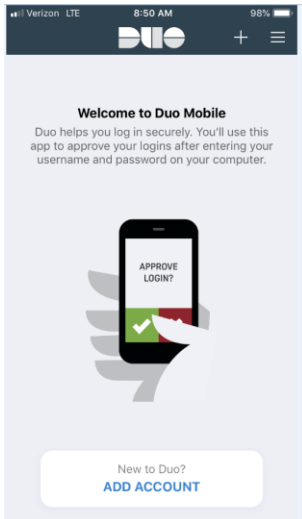
5. Once app is installed, click on the DUO Mobile icon on your phone.



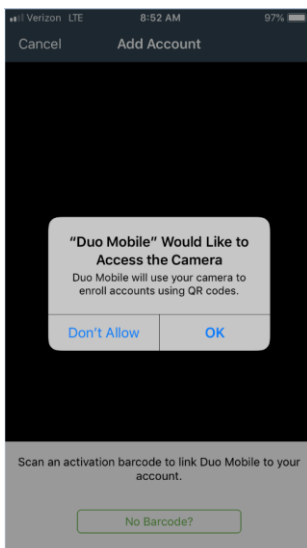
6. The following pop-up window will appear, click “Allow” receive notifications or click “Don’t Allow” if you do not want to receive notifications. Typically, most people select “Allow”, note: this can be changed by you later if you so choose to change your selection.



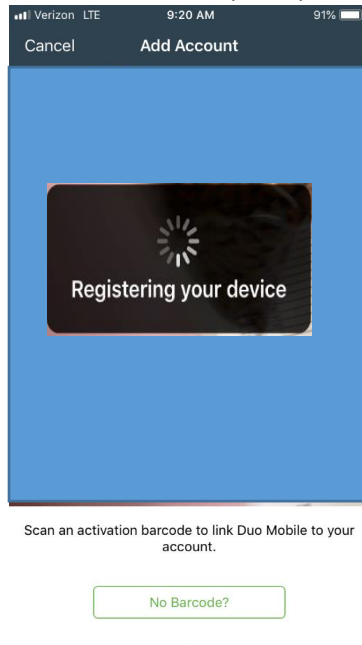
7. On the welcome click “Add Account” at the bottom of the screen.



8. The following pop-up window will appear, click “Ok” or “Don’t Allow” for the app to have access to your phone camera. You must click “Ok”.



9. Your camera will open up.



10. On a computer, login to the UH Login MFA Device Registration site at www.hawaii.edu/its/uhlogin/device-reg enter your “UH Username” and your “UH Password”

Two-factor authentication enhances the security of your account by using a secondary device to verify your identity. This prevents anyone but you from accessing your account, even if they know your password.







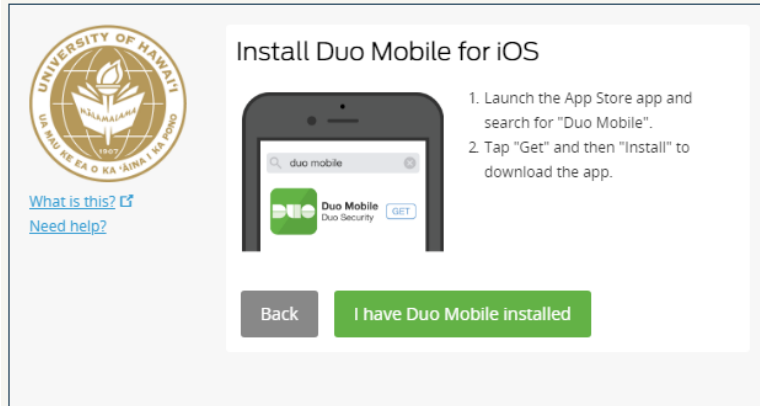

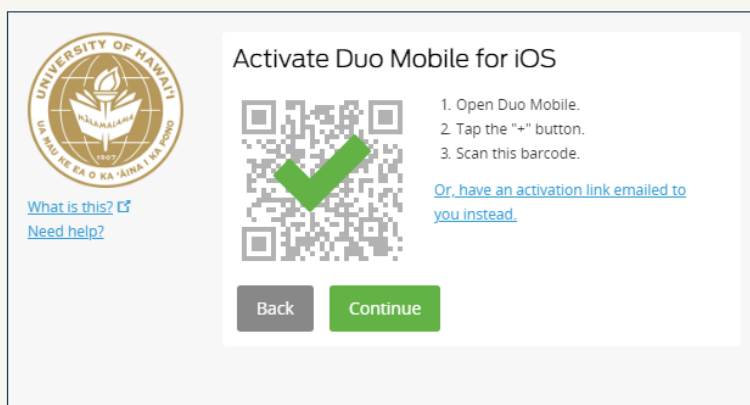
16. Place your phone screen up to the QR code box and your phone camera will automatically register the picture and your account will be activated. Click "Continue".

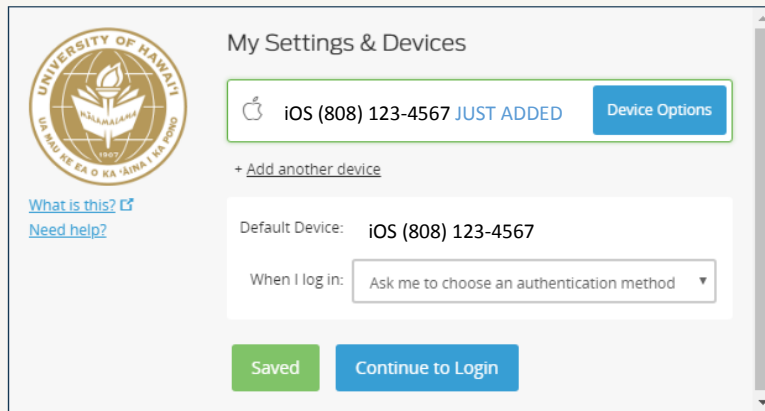
17. The following screen will appear. Click "Continue".

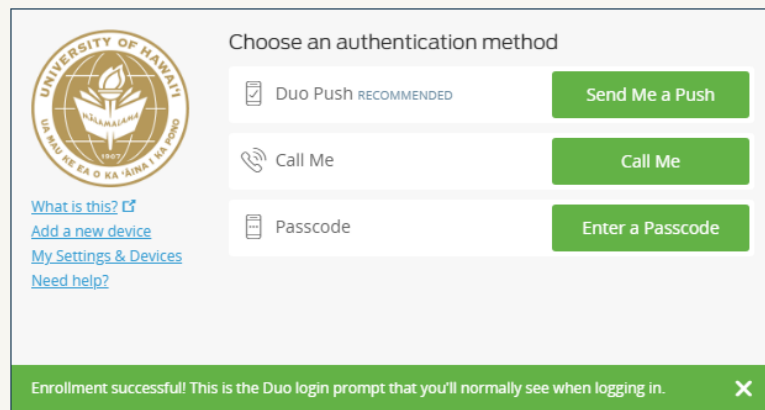

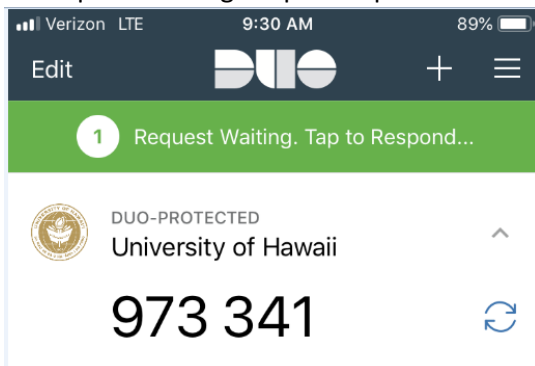


19. The following screen will appear. Click the “Send Me a Push” button.

20. A push notification will be sent to your phone. Click the green banner at the top of your Duo screen that says, “1 Request Waiting. Tap to respond...”



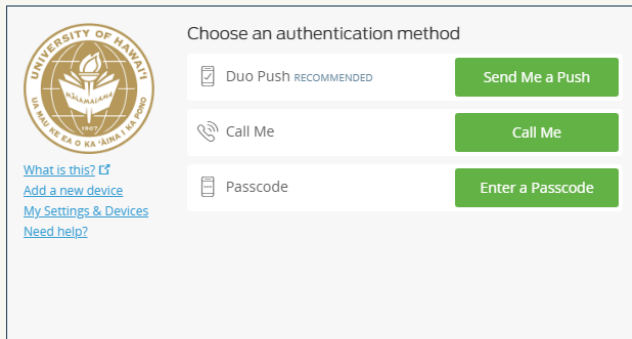
21. Click the "Approve" button.
