## Methodology

Data was extracted from the Operational Data Store (ODS) data warehouse on Monday, September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019 following the fall 2019 Semester census freeze after the close of business on September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2019. The following summary tables and statistics were produced from the frozen data extract.

**Notes:**

- 1) Kapi'olani CC enrollment has declined from 6,899 in fall 2018 to 6,488 in fall 2019, a decline of 6%.
- 2) The Fall 2018 to Fall 2019 enrollment decline is not seen in non-resident enrollment which is essentially unchanged from Fall 2018 (836) to Fall 2019 (830).
- 3) Declines in resident enrollment (from 5,512 in Fall 2018 to 5,145, a decline of 367 and 6.7%) and non-resident military and their dependents (from 307 in Fall 2018 to 252 in Fall 2019, a decline of 55 or 18%) account for nearly all of the Kapi'olani CC Fall 2018 to Fall 2019 enrollment decline.
- 4) The proportion of students enrolled in fall 2019 who were female rose to 60.2% from 58.8% in fall 2018.  
This is due to a disproportionately high decline in male student enrollment of 11.5% from fall 2018 (2,756) to Fall 2019 (2,439). The corresponding numbers for female students in fall 2018 (4,056) and fall 2019 (3,907) represent a 3.7% decline.
- 5) Mean semester hours taken per student dropped from 8.5 in fall 2018 to 8.3 in fall 2019. This appears largely to be the result of an increase in proportion of part-time students from 63.9% in fall 2018 to 66.3% in fall 2019 as the mean semester hours per student for part time students (5.7) and full-time students (13.4) were unchanged from fall 2018 to fall 2019.
