



**Kapi'olani Community College  
 Practical Nursing  
 Program Outcomes**

The Nursing Department at Kapi'olani Community College (KCC) is pleased to share with our community the program outcomes for its Practical Nursing degree in nursing program. The program reports the outcome data to the Hawai'i Board of Nursing, the Hawai'i Center for Nursing and the Kapi'olani Community College through the Annual Report of Program Data (ARPD).

**Expected Level of Achievement:** The Practical Nursing Program mission is to prepare graduates to pass the National Council of Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses (NCLEX-PN), which provides certification to work as a Practical Nurse in that State of Hawai'i and across the U.S. Upon successful completion of all courses and clinical practice, graduates of this program are prepared to take the NCLEX-PN exam for practical nurses and enter practice as an entry-level LPN.

**Outcome 1: NCLEX (Licensure) Pass Rate** - The program demonstrates evidence of graduates' achievement on the licensure examination. The program's most recent annual licensure examination pass rate will be at least 80% for all first-time test-takers during the same 12-month period.

**Outcome 2: Program Completion Rate** - The program demonstrates evidence of students' achievement in completing the nursing program. For the traditional PN in the nursing program option, at least 70% will complete the program within 4 academic terms.
