### Key Findings

1. The female to male gender ratio for all students enrolled at KCC for Spring 2016 is 1.42. The female to male ratio for Native Hawaiian students enrolled at KCC for Spring 2016 is 1.55.
2. KCC is the home base campus for the majority of all enrolled students and Native Hawaiian students. UH Manoa is the second most popular home base campus for both groups.
3. The ratio of part-time to full-status of all students enrolled at KCC is 1.9 part-time students to 1 full-time student. For Native Hawaiian students, the ratio of part-time to full-time is 2.1.
4. For the total number of enrolled students, part-time student semester hours account for 44% of the total 61,018 semester hours taken at KCC this spring. For the Native Hawaiian population, part-time semester hours account for 47% of total hours.
5. The top 5 declared majors of all students at KCC, excluding liberal arts are: 1) Natural Sciences; 2) Hospitality & Tourism; 3) Culinary Arts; 4) Accounting; and 5) Information Technology. The top 5 declared majors of Native Hawaiian students at KCC, excluding liberal arts are: 1) Natural Sciences; 2) Culinary Arts; 3) Hospitality & Tourism; 4) Hawaiian Studies; and 5) Paralegal.
6. For all students, and Native Hawaiians, liberal arts accounts for about 50% of each population's declared major. Likewise, roughly 10% of both populations above is undeclared
7. For this semester, 2.3% of all KCC home based students are classified as early admit. 3.5% of Native Hawaiian students are classified as early admit.
8. The majority (over 90%) of all students enrolled at KCC are from Oahu. This holds true for Native Hawaiians (89.3%). For all students and Native Hawaiians, Hawaii produced the second largest concentration of students.
9. On Oahu, the Honolulu district, followed by Leeward Oahu, contributed the largest number of KCC students for all students and Native Hawaiians.
