The tables generated show the KCC enrollment data for the Spring 2016 Semester. The spring 2016 enrollment data had some particularly interesting findings.

- 1) The mean age for All students for the spring 2016 semester is 24.7 years old while the mean age of Native Hawaiian students attending KCC is 24 years old. The mean age of Filipino students attending KCC is 23.3 years old.
- 2) The female to male gender ratio of All students during the spring 2016 semester is 1.41. For native Hawaiian students the female to male ratio is 1.5 while for Filipino students the female to male ratio is 1.9.
- 3) Across all three demographics (All students, Native Hawaiian, Filipino), the majority of the students had KCC as the home institution. The interesting find is that for all students the next largest population listed UH Manoa as their home institution. For native Hawaiian students, this was also true. The next largest population of Filipino students did not have a 4 year campus as their home base, LCC was the campus that served as the home base to the second largest group of Filipino students attending KCC.
- 4) When looking at the ratio of part-time to full-time status of all students attending KCC, the ratio is 1.86 part-time students to 1 full-time student. It should be noted that full time status is defined as taking 12 semester credit hours or more. When looking at Native Hawaiian students, there is a ratio of 1.51 part-time students for every 1 full-time student. Filipinos showed a larger gap of 1.9 part-time students for every 1 full-time student. This gap difference is +23.3% between Filipinos and Native Hawaiian students and +30.3% gap difference comparing Filipinos to All students.
- 5) Looking at the total semester hours of each of the population groups, the part-time student semester hours constitute 44% of the total 61,018 semester hours while full time-student semester hours constitute the other 56%. The part time student semester hours of Native Hawaiian students constitutes 47% of the total 10,046 student semester hours while full-time student semester hours fill in the missing 53%. Part time Filipino student semester hours compose 52% of the total semester hours while the remaining 48% comes from full-time Filipino student semester hours.
- 6) Top 6 declared majors for All students attending KCC are: 1) Liberal Arts 2) Natural Sciences, 3) Hospitality & Tourism, 4) Culinary Arts, 5) Accounting 6) Information Technology.

Top 6 declared majors of Native Hawaiian students are: 1) Liberal Arts 2) Natural Sciences, 3) Culinary Arts, 4) Hospitality & Tourism, 5) Hawaiian Studies, 6) Para-legal

Top 6 declared majors of Filipino students are: 1) Liberal Arts 2) Hospitality & Tourism, 3) Culinary Arts, 4) Natural Sciences, 5) Accounting, 6) Information Technology.
- 7) Liberal arts constitute nearly 50% of each of the populations declared major. Likewise across the board, 10% of the respective populations were unclassified.
- 8) When looking at the special-early admission of all three groups 2.3% of the students home based out of KCC were classified as early admit (relative to the all student population). Meanwhile, 3.5% of Native Hawaiian students are classified as early admit (relative to the Native Hawaiian student population). Filipinos have a 1.4% early admission rate (relative to Filipino student population).

- 9) When looking at each of the student groups and which Islands students they list as their permanent home address, O`ahu was the clear majority of all three demographic groups. Filipino students and Native Hawaiian students combined constitute 11 of the 18 students whose home residence is on the island of Lāna`i. Similarly 14 of the 16 students who come from Moloka`i are Native Hawaiian or Filipinos..
- 10) When looking at the island of O`ahu, (where the majority of each of the student groups are resident), Native Hawaiian and Filipino population by district looks similar. When looking at All students, east Honolulu had a vastly larger population than both Native Hawaiian and Filipino students. In contrast to both Native Hawaiian and Filipino students who have the windward district as the 3rd most frequent residence on O`ahu, All students have windward O`ahu as their least frequent residence.
