EXAMPLES	Converse with patients and health care professionals; ausultation of BP breath, heart and bowel sounds; respond to paging systems, bells, telephones, and equipment sounds.	Support and transfer patients, move in and out of treatment areas. Reach equipment or parts of patient's body.	Maneuver and operate equipment, pushing/ pulling/carrying; perform CPR.	Distinguish hot or cool skin temperature, pulse rate; feel anatomical landmarks. Distinguish textures, degree of firmness, temperature differences.	Describe patient's skin color, perform calibrations on syringes, administering medications, thermometers, reading and writing patient's charts/flow sheets/ monitors; interpret reagent tests, color of body fluids, changes in skin color.
