What emerged from 314 students voicing their Next Steps Class experiences?


1,589 students were asked to share their feedback on Next Steps Career Exploration Class. 314 [20%] students from three cohorts responded.

A NOTE ABOUT THE PERCENTAGES

N/NUMBER OF RESPONDENTS

The total percentages won't always add up to 100% because students were able to choose more than one answer for some questions, or their open-ended responses were themed in more than one category.

NO, I took one or more college classes in high school. 57% | 177 students


Yes, this was my first college class.

Students who had never taken a college course before had an opportunity to learn skills and gain confidence before embarking on their academic journey this fall:

"I benefitted because I was able to get a perspective of what a college class may look like. My teacher also made sure to use Laulima for our class which was helpful because we were able to have a better understanding of how to use it when we go to college."

How did you hear about taking a free college class? (Check all that apply.) Percentage based out of N/314

51% of students heard about Next Steps through UH email compared to 25% from postcards or 20% who learned about it through a letter. However, the data doesn't show how high school staff or family members learned about Next Steps, both of which provided impactful outreach.




How likely are you to pursue the following this fall? Percentage based out of N/314

Most students will pursue a degree and/or employment in fall 2020.

In hindsight, "job" is vague; respondents could have interpreted this as either seeking part-time employment rather than entering the workforce directly from high school without pursuing further education.

"I gained confidence in myself and became more goal oriented."


On a scale of 1-4...

91% of students feel confident about their fall plans.

45% feel very confident. 46% chose 3 on the 1-4 scale.

Only 2 students (1%) are not at all confident.

26 students (8%) selected 2 on the 1-4 scale.




What obstacles

do you anticipate may interfere with your plan this fall? (Check all that apply.)



Money, health, and safety are top concerns for Next Steps students. Addition write-in responses included issues of uncertainty in career path, fewer opportunities during the pandemic, both physical and mental health issues, transportation, time, and work responsibilities.

Percentage based out of N/314




"I was able to push forward when I wanted to give up. The class gave me an opportunity to create goals and look forward to going something with my life."


"I got the chance to learn from amazing instructors who really gave us a unique perspective of the world."

On a scale of 1-4...


96% of students would recommend Next Steps.




"I learned a lot about myself such as the best times for me to study and I did a project for my class which helped me learn more about my dream career."
